Supply List

Applique Background - 1 yd
Dark Green - 1/2 yd
Light green 1 - FQ
Light green 2 - 10" x 12"
Light green 3 - 5" x wof

Peach fabric 1 - FQ
Peach fabric 2 - 9" x 20"

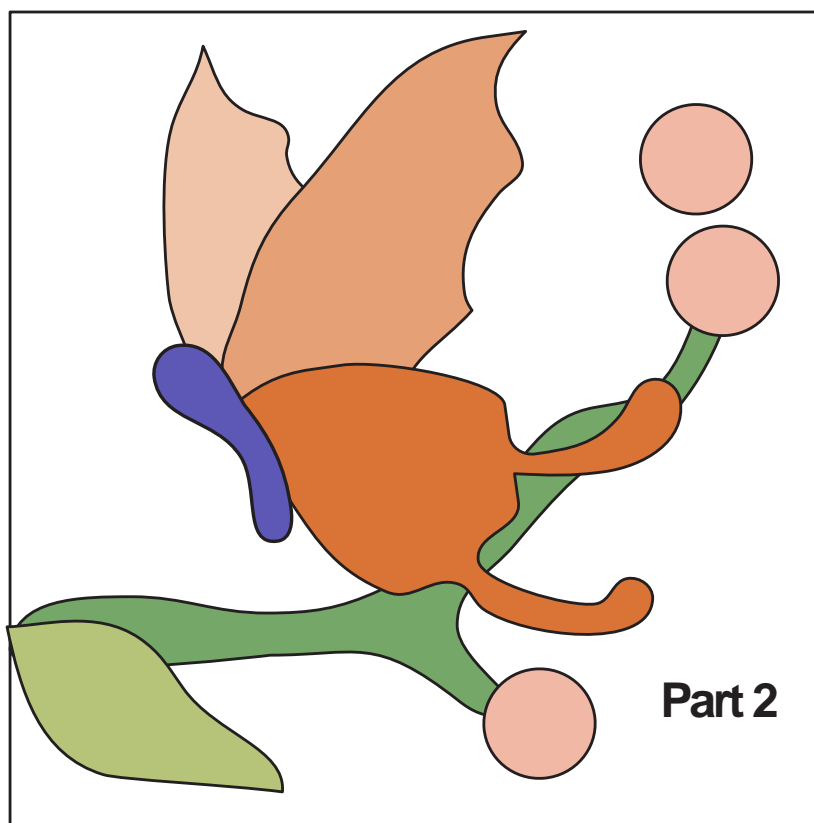
Orange fabric 1 - FQ
Orange fabric 2 - FQ
Orange fabric 3 - FQ
Orange fabric 4 - 10" x 10"

Piecing fabric 1 dark - 1 1/4 yd
Piecing fabric 2 light - 1 1/4 yd

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Backgrounds for Applique

Part 1 - Center block - 10.5" x 12.5"

Part 2 - Cut 1 square 6.5" x 6.5".

FUTURE

- Cut 3 square 6.5" x 6.5".
- Cut 2 strips 4.5" x 22.5"
- Cut 2 strips 4.5" x 14.5"

Recommendation - I would cut all the applique backgrounds now and keep them in your project bag.

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Inner Border

Cut 10 dark squares 3" x 3"

Cut 10 light squares 3" x 3"

Cut 2 light squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 4.5"



Make yourself some Half Square Triangles!

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of your light 3" squares
- Layer a light and dark square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the line
- Cut on the line
- Press open
- Trim each one so it is a 2.5" square (align the ruler's diagonal on the seam)

-Make 20 HST.

Assemble the inner borders following the Diagram.

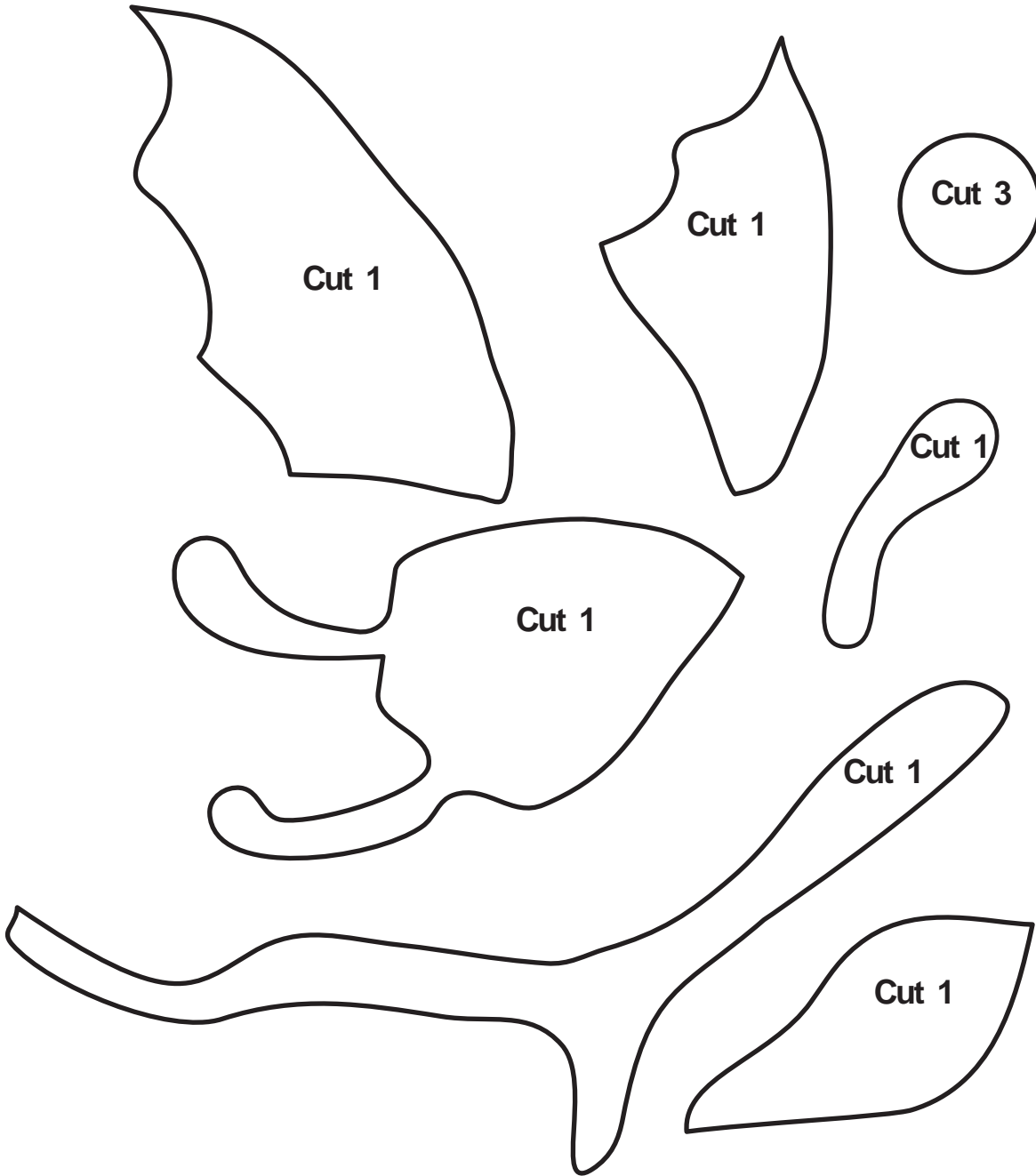
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NOTE - If using my kit please be frugal with the applique. Don't cut out of the center of the fabrics pieces in the kit or you won't have enough.



**ALL Directional Shapes
are reversed for fusible applique**

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
