

## Meadow Breeze Part 7 of 9

## Birds in the Air Block

Cut 2 light squares 7" $\times 7$ " Cut 6 light squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$

Cut 12 print squares 3 " $\times 3$ "


## Make yourself some Half Square Triangles!

-Draw a diagonal line on the back of your light 3 " squares
-Layer a light and dark square. Sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of the line
-Cut on the line
-Press open
-Trim each one so it is a 2.5" square (align the ruler's diagonal on the seam)

## -Make 12 HST

-Cut the remaining 6 squares that are 3 " $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ in half on the diagonal -Cut the 2 large light squares in half on the diagonal

## Assemble the Block

- Sew the blocks in Rows. Using the spare triangles to end the rows.
-Sew the rows to each other
-Sew the large light triangle to the pieced triangle.
-Using your square ruler.. position the ruler diagonal line on the block's seam and trim the block to 6.5 " x 6.5 " square. You may need to trim 4 sides depending on your personal sewing style.
-Make 4 Birds in the Air Blocks. Following the diagram on page 2 sew 2 blocks together and make 2 units (see page 1)
